

## 2026 DVNSW Conference accessibility information

### **Venue**

NSW Teacher's Federation Conference Centre 37 Reservoir Street, Surry Hills NSW 2010.

Sessions will be held in the Auditorium and various rooms within the Centre.

### **Entrance to the venue**

There are two entrances to the Centre, one on Mary Street and one on Reservoir Street – both are accessible.

### **Drop off points**

If you are coming by Taxi/Uber, the best place for drop off is at the entrance on Mary Street Surry Hills.

### **Public transport options**

The venue is close to Central Railway Station – approx. 700 metres. If you are using a motorised or manual wheelchair, it is a reasonably level trip and is more downhill from Central to the Venue and slightly uphill on the trip from the venue to Central.

The venue is also close to the Light Rail, Central Chalmers Street stop.

### **Parking**

The Centre does not have parking.

### **Accessible bathrooms**

There are accessible bathrooms on all levels of the Centre.

### **Hearing loop**

There is a hearing loop available in the auditorium.

### **Moving around the centre**

There are lifts to move between floors and there is Braille signage in some areas.

For wheelchair users and those using mobility aids, there is space at the front of the Auditorium (the rest of the Auditorium has stepped seating. Other rooms being used are accessible.

### **Meal areas**

DVNSW will ensure that meal areas are set up to meet several access needs. We will also have members of staff supporting in case of any gaps. Please let us know when you are registering, if you require any specific assistance.

### **Quiet areas**

There will be a designated quiet space for people to take time away from the proceedings.

### **Places to take assistance animals to toilet**

If you need a park with grass, the closest parks are Belmore Park and Reservoir Street Reserve.
